FIRST SCHEDULE

CONDUCT OF BUSINESS AND AFFAIRS OF THE BOARD

[Part III Clause 14]

1. Quorum of meetings

(1) The quorum for the conduct of business at any meeting of the Board shall be twothirds of the total number of members of the Board.

2. Frequency of meetings

- (1) The Board shall meet at least once every three (3) months.
- (2) Every meeting of the Board shall be convened by the Chairperson in consultation with the Secretary to the Board.
- (3) The notice for meetings under sub section (1) shall be given at least seven (7) days before the date of the meeting
- (4) Notwithstanding the provisions under sub-section (1), the Chairperson of the Board may on his own motion or upon requisition in writing by at least five members of the Board convene a special meeting of the Board at any time for the transaction of a specific business.

3. Chairperson to preside over a meeting of the Board

- (1) The Chairperson shall preside over the meetings of the Board.
- (2) In the absence of the Chairperson, the meeting shall be presided over by the Vice-chairperson.
- (3) In circumstances where both the Chairperson and the Vice-chairperson are absent then the members present shall elect one amongst themselves to preside over the meeting.

4. Decision of the Board

- (1) A decision of the Board on any matter before the Board shall be arrived at either unanimously or by a majority of the votes cast by the eligible members present.
- (2) The *ex-officio* member of the Board shall not be eligible to vote.
- (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-section (1), there shall be a minimum of five eligible voters present and voting.

(4) In circumstances where there is no outright majority of votes cast, then the chairperson will have a casting vote to break the tie.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill seeks to provide a legal framework for establishment of Kilifi County Agricultural Training Centers to ensure provision of specialized and quality agricultural training to the agricultural value chain actors in order to improve food security and standards of living. The Bill seeks to establish and operationalize various Agricultural Training Centers within the County.

The Structure of the Bill is as follows:

Part 1 (clauses 1-3) of the Act contains preliminary provisions. Clause 1 state the title and purpose of the Bill and clause 2 deals with interpretation of the terms as used in the Bill. Clause 3 sets out the object of the Bill.

Part II (clauses 4-5) of the Act deals with establishment and functions of the Kilifi County Agricultural Training Centers to provide education and training in agriculture; and for matters connected and incidental thereto.

Clause 4 states that the County Executive Committee Member may, by order in the Gazette, establish one or more Agricultural Training Centers. Clause 5 outlines the functions of the ATC which are among others, to offer quality competency-based training to Agricultural value chain actors entrepreneurs and agricultural service providers for enhancing agricultural development within the County.

Part III (Clause 6-17) of the Bill provides for Administration. The Part provides for Establishment of the Board to manage the affairs of the ATC.

Clause 6 Establishes a Board of management for the purpose of administration of the ATC.

Clause 7-17 provides for the Membership, appointment, powers, responsibilities of the Board as well as the Principals of the ATC.

Clause 11 and 12 deal with term of office of board as well as vacancy in the office of the member of the Board.

Clause 13 provides for remuneration of the Members of the Board while Clause 14 deals with conduct of business and affairs of the Board. Clause 15 provides for Principals of the ATC how they are appointed and also sets out their functions. Clause 16 proposes that the ATC have a clear guideline on Management of Staff of the ATC.

Clause 17 Protection from Personal Liability of any member of the Board or any officer, employee, agent or servant of the ATC if the act or omission was done for the purposes of executing a function, under the Act.

PART IV (18 -25) of the Bill provides for financial provisions.

Clause 18 Establishes and sets out funds of the ATC. Clause 19 provides for the purpose of the funds.

Clause 20 deals with the Accounts of the ATC. Clause 21-23 provides for the ATC financial year, annual estimates. It also looks at auditing of the accounts to ensure fiscal responsibility. Further, clause 24 deals with annual report while clause 25 is on charges for goods and services. Clause 26 is on adherence to government procurement and disposal procedures

PART V (27-28) of the Bill provides for miscellaneous provisions which includes the powers of the Executive Member to make Regulations and obligatory agricultural policies for the better carrying out of purposes and provisions of the Act. Clause 27 creates offences and penalties for contravening the Act.

PART VI (29) The bill provides for transitional clauses to the Act to give the already existing Agricultural Training Centers a reasonable period to conform to the Act provisions.
