**THE MAKUENI COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2023****A Bill for**

**AN ACT of the County Assembly of Makueni to provide for the imposition or variation of fees, charges, licenses, rents or rates for services pursuant to Article 209 and 210 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 and for connected purposes**

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of Makueni, as follows—

**PART I — PRELIMINARY****Short title and commencement**

1. This Act may be cited as the Makueni County Finance Act, 2023 and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

**Definitions**

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Authorized channel” means the manner in which a person may effect payment to the County Government, including but not limited to payment to a person designated by the Executive Committee Member pursuant to section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, to collect and or receive revenue; or any other mode of payment as may be prescribed from time to time;

“County” means Makueni County;

“County Government” means the Government of Makueni County;

“County Public Officer” means a County public officer within the meaning of section 2 of the County Governments Act, 2012;

“County receiver of revenue” means a person designated pursuant to section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012;

“County Revenue Collector” means a County public officer authorized to collect revenue pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012;

“Executive Committee Member” means the County Executive Committee Member for the time being responsible for matters relating to Finance in the County Government;

“Permit” means an original permit issued under this Act;

“Person” means a natural or juristic person.

## PART II — FEES AND PAYMENTS

### Lands, Housing and Physical planning fees

3. (1) The County Government shall offer the services specified in part 12 and 13 of the third schedule upon receipt of payment of the fee prescribed in the last column of that Schedule. In addition, the County Government shall impose such fees as specified in part 1 of the First Schedule.

(2) A person who wishes to construct a building or structure in the Manner specified in the Third Schedule shall apply for a construction permit to the County Department responsible for Physical Planning.

(3) A person who carries out development within the County without appropriate planning approvals shall be guilty of an Offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty thousand shillings or an imprisonment term not exceeding one year or to both such fine and imprisonment.

(4) A person occupying a plot, stall or a building leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent at the rate Specified in the last column of the relevant parts of the Third Schedule.

(5) The rent referred to under subsection (4) shall be due in case of—

(a) a plot, on the 1st day of January of each year;

(b) a house or stall on the first day of each month.

(6) A penalty of three percent compounded per month shall be charged on the outstanding rent on premises.

(7) The County Government may evict a person who fails to pay for the premise rent for three months.

(8) The County Government may repossess the plot referred to under sub section (4) if the person fails to pay the rent after the 31st day of March.

“Rated value” means the value assigned to all properties in the county by the valuation roll; and

“Valuation Roll” means the legal document consisting of property information of all ratable properties within the boundaries of Makueni County.

### Advertisement

4. (1) A person who wishes to display advertisements and signage in the manner specified in the third Schedule shall apply for a permit to the County Government Department responsible for Physical Planning.

(2) A person who wishes to advertise in the manner specified in the third Schedule shall apply for a permit to the County Government Department responsible for Physical Planning.

(3) The Department of Physical Planning may grant the necessary permit referred to under subsection (2) upon payment of the fees prescribed in the Third Schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be subjected to fines as prescribed under part 36 of the Third Schedule.

### **Market Fees**

5. (1) There shall be a fee for access of markets or stalls for the sale of goods, foods, animals or products as specified in Part 17 and 18 of the Third Schedule.

(2) A person who wishes to access the markets or the stalls for the sale of goods, foods, animals or products shall pay the fees specified in the last column of Part 17 and 18 of the Third Schedule.

(3) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be subjected to fines as prescribed under part 36 of the Third Schedule.

### **Hire of County Government vehicles and machinery**

6. (1) A person shall not use County Government machinery without the relevant authority from the County Government.

(2) A person who wishes to use County Government machinery shall apply to the relevant department within the County Government.

(3) The relevant County Government Department may grant the application under subsection(2) upon the payment of the fee Specified in the last column of Part 11 of the Third Schedule

(4) A person who contravenes the provision of this section Commits an offence and shall be liable for a fine or surcharge of twice the fee prescribed.

### **Fees for County Stadia and Halls**

7. (1) A person shall not use County Stadia, grounds or hall specified in Part 23 or 24 of the Third Schedule without authority from the County Government.

(2) A person who wishes to use County stadia, ground or hall specified in sub-section (1) shall apply for a permit to the relevant County Government Department.

(3) The relevant County Government Department may grant the Permit referred to in subsection (2) upon payment of fees prescribed in the last column of the relevant part of that Schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section Commits an offence and shall be subjected to fines as outlined in part 37 of the Third Schedule.

### **Food and Hygiene**

8. (1) A person shall not sell products, operate a business or receive the services specified in Parts 30 of the Third Schedule without a permit from the County Government.

(2) A person who wishes to sell foods or drugs or receive the County Government services specified in the Third Schedule shall apply for a permit from the relevant County Government Department.

(3) The relevant County Department may grant the permit or provide the services specified in the Third Schedule upon payment of the fee specified in that schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

### **Livestock and veterinary services fees**

9. (1) A person shall not carry out any business or provide the services specified in Part 7 of the Third Schedule Without the authority from the County Government.

(2) A person who wishes to carry out a business or provide the Services specified in part 7 of the Third Schedule shall apply for a permit or certificate to the relevant County Government Department.

(3) The relevant County Government Department may grant the Permit under subsection (2) upon payment of fees prescribed in that Schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

### **Medical and Public Health Services**

10. (1) A person who receives medical or health services from health centers in the County shall be charged the fee specified in the last column of part 30 of the Third Schedule;

(2) The fees applicable to sub section (1) shall not be levied for victims of rape when filing a P3 form in a County medical facility.

**Infrastructure maintenance fee**

11. (1) A person who operates a quarry or transports quarry products, red soil, white clay soil and others from, into or through the County shall pay the fee specified in Part 2 of the Third Schedule.

(2) A person transporting agricultural products from, into or through the County shall be charged the fee specified in Part, 5 and 6 of the third Schedule for the maintenance of infrastructure.

(3) A person who contravenes provisions of this section shall be guilty of offence and shall be subjected to fines as prescribed under Part 37 of the third schedule.

**Tax waivers and variations**

12. The Executive Committee Member may exempt, waive or vary fees or charges payable under this Act in accordance to the criteria prescribed under section 159 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012.

**Amendment of Schedules**

13. (1) The Executive Committee Member may by order published in the *Gazette* amend any of the Schedules to this Act.

(2) An order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within the next twenty-one days on which it next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done thereunder.

**Payments to the County Government**

14. (1) All payments to the County Government shall be made through an authorized channel.

(2) A County Government Revenue Collector or authorized officer shall in the exercise of any functions under this part identify himself or herself.

(3) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County Government.

(4) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County Government unless authorized in writing by the Executive Committee Member.

(5) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.



### **Appointment and Duties of an Agent**

15. (1) In this section—

“Agent” means a person appointed as such under sub-section (2);

“notice” means a notice issued by the Executive Committee Member appointing an agent.

(2) The Executive Committee Member may by written notice addressed to any person—

(a) appoint him or her to be an agent of the County Government for the purposes of collection or recovery of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees, as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Act;

(b) specify the amount of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees to be collected or recovered by the agent.

(3) An agent appointed under this section shall ensure due compliance with the provisions of this Act and remittal of revenue collected to the county receiver of revenue or as may be otherwise instructed in the appointment notice.

(4) Where an agent claims to be, or to have become unable to comply with subsection (2), he or she shall, within seven working days, notify the Executive Committee Member in writing, setting out fully the reasons for his inability to comply, and the Executive Committee Member shall accept the notification and cancel or amend the appointment notice accordingly.

(5) Where an agent fails to issue a notice to the Executive Committee Member under subsection(4), sufficient moneys for the payment of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees specified in the agent's appointment notice shall be presumed to be held by him and this money shall be due and payable to the County Government.

(6) For the purpose of this section, the Executive Committee Member may, by notice in writing, at any time, require any person to furnish him or her, within reasonable time not being less than seven days from the date of service of the notice, with information showing any moneys which may be held by the agent for, or due by him to the County Government.

(7) Where an agent fails to pay an amount of money collected under this section within the time specified in the notice, the provisions of this Act relating to the collection and recovery of revenue shall apply to the collection and recovery of that amount as if it were revenue due and payable by the agent, the due date for the payment of which was the date upon which

that amount should have been paid to the County Government under this subsection.

### **PART III — OFFENCES, ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES**

#### **General Penalties**

**16.** (1) A person who commits an offence under this Act for which no penalty is provided shall be liable upon conviction to a fine as provided by other county laws or any other relevant laws of Kenya.

(2) A person who hinders, obstructs, interferes or prevents an authorized officer, or any other person duly authorized in writing by the Executive Committee Member in exercising the powers under this Act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine of one hundred thousand shillings or to an imprisonment term not exceeding one year or to both.

(3) A person who refuses to give information or gives false information which may lead to under charging in addition to any other remedy under this Act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand shillings or to an imprisonment term not exceeding one year or to both.

#### **Offences by staff of the County Government**

**17.** (1) A county Public Officer or any other person having a duty to perform under this Act who —

- (a) makes in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;
- (b) willfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Act, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Act;
- (d) where required under this Act to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Act, fails to do such thing;
- (e) without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Act;
- (f) willfully contravenes the provisions of this Act to give undue advantage or favor to another person; or
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Act,

Commits an offence and is liable upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both.

### **Cancellation of licenses and permits**

**18.** (1) In addition to the offences under this Act, if any person without lawful authority—

- (a) operates illegal business which cannot be permitted by any law;
- (b) transfers business premises license or permit for purposes of undertaking business in non-designated or permitted area;
- (c) conducts business other than that permitted by the license; shall subject to confirmation by the Executive Committee Member, have their license or permit cancelled thereof;
- (d) any license or permit which is cancelled shall, on notice being given to the holder thereof, be returned to the issuing office within seven days of the receipt of the notice, and where any holder of a cancelled license or permit fails to return the license or permit as aforesaid he shall be guilty of an offence under this Act.

### **Penalties**

**19.** Unless otherwise stated in this Act, any person who contravenes the provisions of this Act shall be liable to a fine not exceeding five thousand shillings in respect of a first offence and not exceeding seven thousand shillings in respect of a second or subsequent offence, or imprisonment for a period not exceeding seven months in respect of a first offence and not exceeding nine months in respect of a second or subsequent, offence or both.

### **Seizure of property**

**20.** (1) The county revenue collector may take into his or her possession any property, for purpose of distressing into compliance the defaulter.

(2) When the property is no longer required under subsection (1), the property must be released as soon as practical to the person entitled to it.

### **Zoning**

**21.** (1) Zoning refers to categorizing fees and charges according to the business geographical location and economic potential.

(2) For effective collection of own source revenue, the county will have three zones; Zone A, Zone B and Zone C.

(3) For the purposes of the Finance Act, 2023—

- (a) Zone A areas comprise of Big Markets such as; Wote town, Emali, Sultan Hamud, Makindu and Kibwezi towns.
  - (b) Zone B areas comprise of medium Markets such as; Salama, Malili, Nunguni, Mukuyuni, Kilala, Kikima, Mbumbuni, Kathonzweni, Kambu, Machinery, Mtito-andei Kiundwani and Tawa
  - (c) Zone C areas comprise of all other Markets.
- (4) Zoning will apply under the following categories of fees and charges—
- (a) Single Business Permit
  - (b) Liquor Licenses
  - (c) Property Rates, Housing and Stall Rent.

**Regulations**

22. The Executive Committee Member may make regulations for purposes of enforcing the provisions of this Act.

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill is prepared pursuant to Section 133 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 and Standing Order 218 of the County Assembly Standing Orders which requires the County Finance Bill to be presented to the Assembly as a legislative proposal.

The Bill seeks to provide for the various taxes, fees and other service charges that are payable to the Makueni County Government. These are set out in the Schedules. This is to enhance the revenue payable to the County Government for enhanced the service delivery and to enable the County Government perform the increased functions bestowed on it by the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution.

**Statement on delegated powers to legislate**

The Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance is empowered to bring into operation the various provisions of the Act or certain sections of the Schedule. This is to enable the putting in place of the necessary physical, administrative and personnel infrastructure that would aid in the operationalization of the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

The operationalization of certain provisions of the proposed law shall entail an expenditure of public funds. The funds will be provided for in the estimates.
