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THE LAMU COUNTY INTERNSHIP SERVICE ACT, 2022

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Lamu to provide establishment of internship service and for connected purpose

ENACTED by County Assembly of Lamu, as follows -

PART I - PRELIMINARY

Short title

This Act may be cited as the Lamu County Internship Service.
2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires-

"County Executive Committee Member" means the Con Executive Committee Member for the time being responsible for Con Public Service;

"department" means department responsible for the County Pu Service;

"graduate" means a person who has graduated from a univercollege, polytechnic or home craft center;

"internship" means placement of a person in workplace for purpose of gaining work experience, knowledge and practical skills;

"placement unit" means the internship placement unit establis under section 5; and

"student" means a person who is enrolled in a university, coll polytechnic or home craft center.

Object of the Act

- 3. The object of this Act is to provide for a legal framework for promotion and fulfillment of Article 55 of the Constitution through establishment of the County Internship Service in order to facilitate enable university and college students and graduates to –
 - (a) gain necessary practical work experience;
 - (b) learn appropriate and relevant professional knowledge

Internship Placement Unit

- (1) There shall be in the department, the Internship Placem Unit.
 - (2) The Internship Placement Unit shall be responsible for-
 - (a) coordinating of the the internshipservice:
 - (b) receiving and reviewing internships applications;
 - (c) coordinating placement persons recruited under service,
 - (d) organizing and coordinating training provided to persons serv in the internship service;
 - (e) promoting the development of the internship service;
 - (f) ensuring effective implementation of this Act; and
 - (g) handling disputes arising from the internship service.

Placement Officers

There shall be such internship placement officers in the departm as may be determined by the County Executive Committee Member.

Placement entity

- A placement entity where a person recruited in the internsl service shall be —
 - (a) County Executive departments and entities;
 - (b) National Government ministries and entities; or
 - (c) non state entity.

Collaboration and partnership

8. The department shall initiate collaboration and partnership with the placement entities described under section 7 (b) and (c) for the purposes placing persons in the internship programme with the entities.

Eligibility

placed in the internship service which shall provide for allocations per county department or entity, national government private entities.

- (2) For the purpose of preparing the placement plan under subsection (1)—
 - (a) each County department or entity shall, before thirty first of M in each financial year, submit to the Internship Placement Ur the number of available internship positions, and who applicable the required fields of training or professions; and
 - (b) the Internship Placement Unit shall, before thirty first of M in each financial year, ensure that it has compiled a list national government and private sector institutions with t respective available internship positions or vacanci including where applicable the required fields of training professions.
- (3) The plan prepared under subsection (1) shall be approved by t County Executive Committee.
- (4) For the purposes of commencing the first internsh programme under this Act during the financial year 2020/2021, t County Executive Committee shall approve the number of internsh positions for each department that shall be available during the financiyear.

Application for internship

- (1) A person who qualifies for internship under this Act, mapply in the prescribed form for internship to the Internship Placeme Unit.
- (2) An application made under this section shall be accompanie by
 - (a) in the case of a student, are commendation letter fi internship from the college or university where the student enrolled; and

(b) in the case of a graduate a university or college coefficient

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(4) The Internship Placement Unit shall upon the completion of review process under subsection (3) prepare a database of applicants and their respective fields of training or professions.

Internship placement

- 12. (1) The Internship Placement Unit shall convene an in departmental forum, consisting one representative from each departm within one month upon the coming into force of this Act and therea at least once in each period of 3 months for the purposes of placing various applicants to the respective departments.
- (2) The forum convened under subsection (1) shall consider approve the applications for persons to be granted internship opportuni in the various placement entities.
- (3) In placing the applicants for internship, the Internship Placen Unit shall
 - (a) ensure that there is balance in regard to matters such as gen-Ward representation and ethnic diversity; and
 - (b) where applicable, place each person whose application been approved in a job area that is related to the applicant's a of training.
- (4) Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to prohibit a person wh eligible under section 9 to be placed in an internship position on account that the person is not a resident in the county.

Letter service of internship

13. The Department shall issue a letter of internship offer to a per whose application has been approved under section 12, which s indicate among others the terms and conditions of the internship and job placement offered.

Term of service

- 14. (1) The term of service for internship shall-
- (a) in the case of a student, for a period not exceeding the months; and graduates six months.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2) a person who has served internship term as a student is qualified to serve in internship program as a graduate.

Terms and conditions of service

- 15. (1) An internship service shall not be construed to be employm with the county government or any private sector entity participating the programme.
- (2) A person serving in the internship programme may be paid su allowances as shall from time to time be determined by County Executi Committee.
- (3) Subsection (2) shall be applicable to any person serving in internship programme irrespective of whether the person is placed in public or private organization.
- (4) A person serving in the internship programme shall be bound the code of conduct and practice governing the County Public Officers.

Duties of a placement entity

- 16. A placement entity shall have a duty to-
- (a) facilitate learning and exposure to the person serving in ternship;
- (b) assign duties or tasks to the person serving in the internship;
- (c) assign a supervisor to the person serving in the internsl programme; and
- (d) provide administrative support to the person serving in t internship for the purposes of earrying out the assigned tasks

Duties of a person serving in the internship programs

- 17. A person serving in the internship programme has a duty to
- (a) carry out duties and tasks assigned; and
- (b) comply with code of conduct for County Public Officers.

Supervision

Training

- 19. (1) The placement unit shall in collaboration with other placement entities design and facilitate training for all per participating in the internship programme.
- (2) The training described under subsection (1) shall address ma such as devolution, leadership, life skills, public sector managen public policy, national values and entrepreneurship among others.
- (3) The Internship Placement Unit shall ensure that the trainin conducted as part of orientation of the persons participating in internship programme.

Termination of internship

- A person serving in the internship programme shall cease f serving under the programme through—
 - (a) resignation from the programme through a two week writed notice; or
 - (b) the department terminating the service on account of broad of county government code of ethics and practice govern county public officers.
 - (c) the expiry of the internship period unless otherwise exter in accordance with section (14) of this Act.

Internship exit report

- 21. (1) Each person participating in the internship programme s compile an exit report at the end of the term of service which shall submitted to the supervisor.
 - (2) The report shall cover matters such as-
 - (a) lessons learnt;
 - (b) challenges experienced;
 - (c) recommendations for improving the programme; and
 - (d) any other matter as may be required by the placement

Annual internship service report

23. The placement unit shall prepare an annual report or internship service which shall be submitted to the County Exec Committee for consideration then forwarded to the County Assemb discussion.

PART III - FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

Funding of the internship service

- 24. The funding of the internship service shall consist of
- (a) such monies as may be appropriated by the County Assemb that purpose; or
- (b) such grants and donations from any lawful source.

PART IV-GENERAL PROVISIONS

Regulations

- (1) The County Executive Committee Member may Regulations for better carrying out of the objects of this Act.
- (2) Without prejudice to the foregoing the regulations shall prefor—
 - (i) application forms;
 - (ii) criteria for placement.
