

## PART III—COUNTY VILLAGES SCHEDULE

AN ACT of the Kitui County Assembly to provide for the establishment of Villages, the effective coordination, management and supervision of the general administrative functions in the villages; and for connected purposes

**ENACTED** by the Kitui County Assembly of Kitui as follows—

#### PART – I PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Kitui County Villages Act, 2015 and shall come in operation upon gazettement in County or *Kenya gazette*.

Short title and Commencement.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

"County" means the County of Kitui as established under Article 176 of the Constitutions of Kenya 2010.

"County Government" means the Government of Kitui County.

No. 17 of 2012.

"County Public Service Board" means the Board established under section 57 of the County Governments Act, 2012.

No. 17 of 2012.

"Ward' means an electoral area within a county delimited in accordance with Article 89 of the Constitution and section 26 of the County Government Act, 2012;

No. 17 of 2012.

"Village" means the decentralized unit of the County Government delimited in accordance with section 48 of the County Government Act, 2012.

"Sub-County administrator" means the person responsible for coordination and administration of county affairs in any one of the eight sub-counties in Kitui County and appointed as such as per the County Governments Act;

No. 17 of 2012.

"village administrator" means the person responsible for overall co-ordination and management of county affairs in a particular village in the county and appointed as such as per the County Governments Act;

No. 17 of 2012.

"village council" means the council established under section 53(1) of the County Governments Act, 2012; and

No. 17 of 2012.

"ward administrator" means the person responsible for overall co-ordination and management of county affairs in a particular ward in Kitui County appointed as such in accordance with the County Governments Act;

**3.** The object and purpose of this Act is to provide for the establishment of the Village Units in Kitui County so as to provide for the further decentralization of the functions and provision of services by the Kitui County Government in accordance with Article 176(2) of the Constitution.

Purpose and object of the Act.

### PART—II ESTABLISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF VILLAGES

**4.** There is established in Kitui County Two Hundred and Forty Seven (read 247) villages for proper coordination and facilitation of citizen participation in the development of policies and plans and delivery of services.

Establishment of Village units.

5. All villages established under this Act shall be as per the Schedule to this Act.

Villages to be as per the Schedule.

**6.** Each of the established village unit under section 3 shall be administered by a Village Administrator in accordance with the provisions of Section 52 of The County Governments Act, 2012.

Administration of Villages.

7. The village administrator shall be appointed by the Kitui County Public Service Board from persons who possess professional and technical qualifications in public administration.

Establishment of the office of the village administrator.

**8.** The Village Administrator shall be responsible to the respective Ward Administrator and shall have the following responsibilities:—

Functions o the village administrator.

- (1) Co-ordinating, managing and supervising the general administrative functions in the village;
- (2) Facilitating the community in the development of policies and plans;
- (3) Ensuring effective service delivery by the county government;
- (4) Co-ordinating county government development activities to empower the community;
- (5) Providing and maintaining infrastructure and facilities for effective delivery of public services by the county;
- (6) Exercising any functions and powers delegated to him or her by the County Public Service Board

pursuant to provisions of section 86 of the County Governments Act, 2012.

**9.** (1) A Village Administrator shall coordinate, manage and supervise the general administrative functions in the village including—

Power of the Village Administrator.

- (a) Pursuant to Paragraph 14 of Part II of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution—
  - (i) Ensuring and co-ordinating the participation of the village unit in governance; and
  - (ii) Assisting the village unit to develop administrative capacity for the effective exercise of the functions and powers and participation in governance at the local level.
- (b) The exercise of any functions and powers delegated to him or her by the County Public Service Board under Section 86 of the County Governments Act of 2012:
- (2) (In carrying out the functions and obligations subsection (1), a village administrator shall be responsible to the relevant Ward Administrator.
- 10. There shall be established in each village unit a village council in accordance with Section 53 of the County Governments Act, 2012. The village council shall consist of the village administrator and not less than three and not more than five village elders with the Village Administrator as the Chairperson.

Establishment of village council.

11. The Village councils shall be responsible for the following:—

No. 17 of 2012. Functions of the village council.

- (1) Co-ordinating and ensuring citizen participation in the county governance;
- (2) Assisting respective village to develop administrative capacity for the effective exercise of function and powers;
- (3) Monitoring the implementation of policies and programs at the village level;
- (4) Advising the Ward Administrator and Sub-County Administrator on the matters pertaining to the Village; and
- (5) Any other function necessary for the better administration of the Village.

12. The provisions of this Act shall be complimentary to the provisions of the County Governments Act in relation to the establishment and administration of the Village units within the County.

Provisions in the Act are Complimentary.
