

THE VIHIGA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2023

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THE VIHIGA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2023

ABILL of the County Assembly of Vihiga to provide for the imposition or variation of various fees, charges, licenses, rents or rates for services and for connected purposes

ENBILLED by the County Assembly of Vihiga, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement

1. This BILL may be cited as the Vihiga County Finance BILL, 2023 and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

Interpretation

2. In this BILL, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Authorized Channel” means the manner in which a person may effect payment to the County, including but not limited to a person designated by the executive committee member pursuant to Section 157 of the Public Finance Management BILL, 2012, to collect or receive revenue or any other mode of payment as may be prescribed from time to time;

“Business” means—

- (a) trade, commerce or manuf BILL ure, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) any other BILL livity in the nature of trade, commerce or manuf BILL ure, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (c) any BILL livity carried out by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration;

“County” means the County Government of Vihiga;

“County Public Officer” means a county public officer within the meaning of Section 2 of the County Governments BILL, 2012;

“County Receiver of Revenue” means the persons appointed pursuant to Section 157 of the Public Finance Management BILL, 2012;

“County Revenue Collector” means the County Public Officer appointed pursuant to Section 158 of the Public Finance Management BILL, 2012;

“Executive Committee Member” means the Executive Committee Member for the time being responsible for matters relating to finance in the County;

“Person” means a natural or juristic person;

“Cess” means a levy charged on tradeable agricultural land and natural resources within the county;

“Zone A” means the area comprising of the faraway areas previously under the defunct Vihiga county council;

“Zone B” means the area comprising of the fair/prime areas previously under

the defunct vihiga county council;

“Zone C” means the area comprising of the far away areas previously under the defunct Luanda and vihiga municipal council;

Zone D means the area comprising of the fair/prime location areas previously under the defunct Luanda and vihiga municipal council.

PART II—FEES AND TAXES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

General Fees and Charges

3.(1) A person who wishes to carry out the BILL activities specified in the First Schedule shall pay the fees specified in the last column of the relevant Part of that Schedule.

(2) A person who wishes to start carrying out any of the BILL activities listed under Part IV of the First Schedule shall apply for a permit to the County.

(3) A person who currently has a Single Business Permit regarding BILL activities listed under Part IV of the First Schedule who is simply re-newing their Single Business Permit shall not pay application fees.

(4) The County shall grant the relevant permit(s) to the applicant(s) upon payment of fees prescribed in the County Single Business Permit BILL.

(5) All distributors operating in Vihiga County shall be required to acquire a distribution Permit from the county Government of Vihiga.

(6) Late payment of Single Business Permit shall attract BILL penalty of 5% per month.

(7) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Parking Fees and Penalties

4.(1) A person whose County parking shall be charged a fee specified in the Second Schedule.

(2) There shall be penalties for late payment of parking fees, impounding of vehicles or withdrawal of court bond as specified in Part of

(3) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section, commits an offence.

Solid Waste and Environmental Management

5.(1) A person who wishes to receive or carry out the services specified in the Third Schedule shall pay the fees specified in the relevant Part of that Schedule.

(2) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Lands and Physical Planning Fees

6.(1) A person who carries out development within the County without the appropriate planning approval shall be charged specific penalties specified in the Fourth Schedule.

(2) A person who wishes to construct a building or structure in the manners specified in the Fourth Schedule shall apply for a construction permit to the County Department responsible for Physical Planning.

(3) A person occupying a plot, stall or a building leased or rented out by the County shall pay rent, at the rates specified in the last column of the relevant Part of the Fourth Schedule.

(4) The rent referred to under subsection (6)(3) shall be due in case—

(a) a plot, on the 1st day of January in each year;

(b) a house or a stall, on the 30th day of each month.

(5) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsections (6) or (4) (b) may be evicted if he fails to pay the rent for three consecutive months.

(6) A penalty of three percent per month or a part thereof shall be charged on the outstanding rent on a plot that remains unpaid after 31st day of March.

(5) The County may repossess the plot referred to under subsection (5) above if the person fails to pay the rent for more than three consecutive years.

(6) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Hire of Machinery

7.(1) A person shall not use County machines without permission from the relevant county authority - permission to be granted by Department.

(2) A person who wishes to use a county machine shall apply to the relevant authority within the county.

(3) The minimum chargeable hours are four (4) hours.

(4) The relevant county authority may grant the application under subsection (2) upon the payment of fees specified in the Fifth Schedule.

(5) A person who contravenes the provision of this section commits an offence.

Infrastructure and Maintenance Fee

8.(1) A person who operates a quarry or transports quarry products, red soil, or manure from north through the County shall pay a fee specified in the Fourth Schedule for the maintenance of infrastructure.

(2) A person transporting agricultural products from north through the County shall be charged a fee specified in the schedule for the maintenance of infrastructure.

(3) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Fees for use of County Stadiums, Grounds or Halls

9.(1) A person shall not use the County Stadium, Ground or Hall as specified in the Sixth Schedule without permission from the relevant County authority as per the relevant department.

(2) A person who wishes to use the County Stadium, Ground or Hall specified in sub-section (1) above shall apply for a permit to the relevant County authority.

(4) The relevant County authority may grant the permit referred to in subsection (2) upon payment of fees prescribed in the last column of the relevant part of that Schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Food and Drugs Permit and Health Services

10.(1) A person shall not sell the products, operate the business or receive the services as specified in the Seventh Schedule without a permit from the relevant County authority i.e. concerned department.

(2) A person who wishes to sell food or drugs or receive the County services specified in the Seventh Schedule shall apply for a permit from the Department responsible for Public Health.

(3) The Department may grant the permit or provide the services specified in the Seventh Schedule upon payment of the fees specified in that Schedule.

(4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Livestock and Veterinary Services Fees

11.(1) A person shall not sell the products, operate the business or receive the services specified in Part I of the Eighth Schedule without a permit from the relevant county authority i.e. concerned department.

(2) A person who wishes to sell food or drugs or receive the County services specified in the Eighth schedule shall apply for a permit from the Department responsible for Public Health.

(3) The Department may grant the permit or provide the services specified in the Schedule upon payment of the fees specified in that schedule

(5) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Public Medical Health Services

12. A person who receives medical or health services from the health centres in the County shall be charged a fee specified in the Seventh Schedule.

Advertisement

13.(1) A person who wishes to display advertisements and signages in the manners specified in the Ninth Schedule shall apply for a permit to the County Department responsible for Revenue.

(2) The Department may grant the necessary permit referred to under subsection 9 upon payment of fees prescribed in the Schedule.

(3) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence

Tax Waivers Variations

14.(1) The Executive Committee Member may with the approval of the County Executive Committee exempt, waive or vary fees or charges payable under this BILL in accordance to the criteria prescribed in the BILL.

(2) Persons Living with Disabilities in possession of a certificate of disability shall pay sixty percent (60%) of the respective taxes, fees and charges as provided for in this BILL.

Impoundment

15. The areas and offices within the Sub-county revenue offices, the Vihiga Municipal grounds and the Vihiga County headquarters shall BILL as yards for storage of impounded goods.

Amendments to Schedules

16.(1) The Executive Committee Member may by order published in the *Gazette* amend any of the Schedules.

(2) Any order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within the next twenty-one dayson which it next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done thereunder.

PART III—PAYMENT

Payments to the County

17.(1) All payments to the County shall be paid through an authorized channel.

(2) A County Revenue Collector or enforcement officer enforcing this BILL shall have an identification card issued by the County.

(3) The identification card issued under subsection (2) shall be worn visibly by the officer when carrying out any of the functions under this BILL.

(4) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County.

(5) Any payment made to the County shall be evidenced by an official receipt.

(6) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County unless he has been authorized to do so.

(7) A person who contravenes the provisions of this Section commits an offence.

Appointment and duties of an agent

18. Appointment and duties of an agent shall be as specified in the County Revenue Administration BILL, 2015.

PART IV – SEIZURE OF GOODS

19.(1) An authorized revenue collector may seize goods if he has reasonable grounds to believe that revenue in respect of the goods has not been paid.

(2) Goods seized under subsection (1) shall be stored in a place approved by the County Receiver of Revenue or authorized revenue collector in a manner to ensure the security of the goods.

(3) When the goods referred to in subsection (1), have been seized, the authorized revenue collector shall, having regard to the conditions of the goods, serve the owner of the goods or the person who has custody or control of the goods, a notice in writing—

- (a) Identifying the goods.
- (b) Stating that the goods have been seized under this section and the reasons for seizure.
- (c) Setting out the terms for the release or disposal of the goods;
- and (d) Stating that the goods shall be forfeited to the County, if not claimed in accordance with subsection (4).

(4) The County Receiver of Revenue or authorized revenue collector may authorize the goods to be released to whom the notice was served under subsection (3) when that person pays or has given security for the payment of revenue due and payable, in respect of the goods.

(5) If subsection (4) does not apply, the County Receiver of Revenue or the authorized revenue collector shall detain the goods seized under subsection (1).

- (a) In case of perishable goods, for a period that is reasonable, having regards to the conditions of the goods; or
- (b) In any other case, for thirty days after the seizure.

(6) When the retention period under subsection (5) has expired, the goods shall be treated as having been forfeited by the owner to the County Receiver of Revenue.

(7) The County Receiver of Revenue may sell the forfeited goods through a public auction or any other approved means.

PART V—PENALTIES AND OFFENCES

General Penalty

19. A person who commits an offence under this BILL for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding

twenty thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or both.

Offences by staff of the County

20. A member of staff of the County or any other person having a duty to perform under this BILL who—

- (a) makes, in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe to be true or to be false;
- (b) wilfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this BILL, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this BILL;
- (d) where required under this BILL to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this BILL, fails to do such thing;
- (e) without reasonable cause avoids to do something in breach of his or her duty under this BILL;
- (f) wilfully contravenes the provisions of this BILL to give undue advantage or favour to another person; or
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this BILL; Commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both.

PART VI—MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Savings

21.(1)(a) Any charges, permit fees, licenses fees, rent, infrastructure maintenance fee and such other fees payable to the County at the commencement of this BILL but which are not included in any of the Schedules to this BILL, shall continue to apply until specific county legislation is enacted.

(2) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations, or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of fees and charges given or issued by the previous county councils, municipal councils, town councils or urban councils, before the commencement of this BILL shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the County Assembly until the expiry or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations, and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, to apply, be paid and administered under this BILL. Provided that this subsection shall also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments of the National Government in respect of functions devolved to the county under Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution which fees and charges shall be levied by the County on performance of the devolved functions.

(3) All references to Councils shall include all Local Authorities as were defined under the now repealed Local Government BILL, Cap. 265 of the Laws of Kenya.

Cessation

22. Unless otherwise provided in this BILL, the rates for fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent applicable to the goods, services or activities listed in the Schedules before the commencement of this BILL shall cease to apply.

Regulations

23. The Executive Committee Member may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this BILL.

Advance Payments

24.(1) Notwithstanding the units of measure of time provided in the Schedules to this BILL the Executive Committee Member in charge of Finance shall give provision for advance payments for a period of Three (3) months, Six (6) and Twelve (12).

(2) Where a person elects to pay in advance as in subsection (a), the County shall issue a special card showing the details of the payment and expiry of the same.

(5) The Executive Committee Member may with approval of the County Executive Committee provide for discounts under this section to encourage advance and timely payments.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS
Statement of Objects and Reasons for the Bill

The Constitution mandates County Government to levy charges for services provided and to generally fund the activities provided under the Forth Schedule of the Constitution. The said revenue is meant to supplement the allocation from the National Government to the County with a view to financing the County Budget.

The Finance Bill is mandatory for the completion of legal instruments and budgetary process. The Bill formulates the proposals announced in the Budget relating to collection of Revenue and other Taxes for matters incidental thereto.

It raises various categories of levies and charges that shall be applied to various services to the County in line with the market rates.
