THE SIAYA COUNTY VILLAGE ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS ACT, 2020

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Siaya to provide for the creation of Village Administrative Units, offices of the Village Administrators and Village Councils, procedures for restructuring Village Units and participation in the implementation of Public oriented development projects; and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Siaya as follows-

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title and Commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Siaya County Village Administrative Units Act, 2020 and shall come into force upon publication in the Gazzette.

Interpretation

2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires —

"boundaries of administrative units" means those boundaries of existing locations and sub-locations considered to be the boundaries for the village units;

"gross misconduct" means wrongful, improper or unlawful conduct motivated by premeditated or intentional purpose or by obstinate indifference to the consequences of one's act.

"sub-county" means an administrative area equivalent to the elective constituencies in the country as defined under section 48 (1) b of County Government Act 2012 and provided for under Article 89 of the constitution;

"village administrative units" means governance units to be determined as per requirements of Section 53 of the County governments Act, (1.d);

"village administrator" means a person appointed by The County Government to be the public servant responsible for coordination of all public service and development in the village unit;

"ward" means an administrative area equivalent to the electoral wards defined by the Constitution under Article 89 of the Constitution and section 26 of the County Government Act 2012; and

"ward administrator" means a person appointed by the County Government to be the public servant responsible for coordination of all public ser "e and development in the ward.

"sub-county" means an administrative area equivalent to the elective constituencies in the country as defined under section 48 (1) b of County Governments Act, 2012 and provided for under Article 89 of the

PART II—ESTABLISHMENT OF THE VILLAGE UNITS **Establishment of Village Units**

- 3. (1) There is established seventy five (75) Village Units in accordance with Section 48 (1) (d) of the County Governments, Act.
- (2) In establishing the village units the County Assembly took into account the following factors as listed in section 48 (3) (a-d)-
 - (a) population size;
 - (b) geographical features:
 - (c) community of interest, historical, economic and cultural ties; and
 - (d) means of communication.

PART III—ESTABLISHMENT OF THE OFFICE OF THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

Establishment of the Office of the Village Administrator

- 4. (1) There is established for each village unit the Office of the Village Administrator.
- (2) The village administrator shall have professional qualifications and technical knowledge in administration and shall be competitively appointed by the County Public Service Board in accordance with the

Powers and Responsibilities of Village Administrators

- 5. (1) A village administrator shall co-ordinate, manage and supervise the general administrative functions in the village pursuant to paragraph 14 of part II of the Forth Schedule to the Constitution including -
 - (a) ensuring and coordinating the participation of the village unit in governance;
 - (b) assisting the village unit to develop the administrative capacity for the effective exercise of the functions and powers and participation in governance at the local level; and
 - (c) exercising any functions and powers delegated by the County Public Service Board under section 86 of the County Governments Act.
- (2) In carrying out the functions and obligations in Subsection (1) (a) the village administrator shall be responsible to the relevant Ward

PART IV—ESTABLISHMENT OF THE VILLAGE COUNCILS

Establishment of Village Council

6. There is established, for each village unit, a Village Council.

Composition of the Village Council

- 7. The Village Council shall comprise of the following —
- (a) the village administrator who shall be the Chairperson of the Village Council; and
- (b) not less than three and not more than five village elders competitively appointed by the County Public Service Board taking into account gender balance and persons with disabilities.

Qualifications for appointment into the Village Council

- 8. (1) A person shall be eligible for appointment as a Village elder if the person—
 - (a) is a citizen of Kenya;
 - (b) above 18 years of age;
 - (c) has been a resident of or has been the owner of property in the respective village unit for a continuous period of not less than five years prior to the appointment date;
 - (d) meets the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution; and
 - (e) is not disqualified for appointment to the office by the County Government Act or any other law.

Allowances for Members of the Village Council

9. A village elder shall be paid such allowance as shall be determined by the County Assembly.

Powers and Responsibilities of the Village Council

- 10. A village council shall be responsible for—
- (a) ensuring and coordinating the participation of the Village unit in governance;
 - (b) assisting the village unit to develop the administrative capacity for the effective exercise of the functions and powers and participation in governance at the local level;
- (c) monitoring the implementation of policies at the village unit;
- (d) advising the village administrator on matters pertaining to the Village; and
- (e) any ther function necessary for the better administration of the village up

Terms of Service

11. The members of a village council shall serve until the appointment of a new council after the next general election.

Vacancy in the Village Council

- 12. (1) The position of a village elder shall become vacant upon —
- (a) death
- (b) bankruptcy;
- (c) insanity;
- (d) resignation
- (e) voluntary retirement; or
- (f) removal from office due to gross misconduct.
- (2) In case of gross misconduct by any village elder the village administrator shall petition the County Assembly to investigate and upon verification of the allegation remove from office such a village elder.

PART V—RESTRUCTURING OF VILLAGE UNITS

Procedure for Restructuring of Village Units

- 13. If and when the need for restructuring of the existing village units arises, the following procedure shall be followed—
 - (a) any party proposing any restructuring shall present his or her proposal to the County Executive Committee in charge of Decentralized Units and Urban areas;
 - (b) the County Executive Committee shall conduct public consultations and participation on the said proposals;
 - (c) the county assembly shall approve to the change of the number of village units.

PART VI—MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Dispute Resolution

14. In case of any dispute arising in relation to the restructuring Process, the County Assembly shall have the final word.

Power to make Regulations

15. The County Executive Committee in charge of Decentralized Units in consultation with the County Assembly may make regulations for the better carrying out of its functions under this Act.
